

## November 2005 Meeting Minutes

This month's meeting was held November 17th at the Samuell Grand Recreation Center in Dallas. There were 11 in attendance, including new member **Ron Romeo** and guests **John Brodie, Steve Wolf, Monte Rorie, and James Glover.**

**Ralph Snow** reported \$4477.54 in the club treasury as of November 16th. This is an increase of nearly \$400 since the September meeting and represents proceeds from the DEAF 19th Fly-In as well as membership renewals.

The present club officers all agreed to have their names put in nomination for re-election in January. No additional nominations were received.

**Ralph Snow** reported that the Seven Towers club had rejected the January 14th date for a joint fun-fly because of concerns about the weather. A date later in the spring will probably be decided upon some time in the future. It was decided that the club will not schedule a flying event for January.

**Ron Morris** reported that the Rowlett club is not in a position to discuss a joint event with DEAF at this time because of problems they are having with the city authorities.

It was proposed that the February 11th flying session should be an electric combat event and fun-fly. **John Brodie** and his group will be invited to participate. John gave a presentation with some of his foam war bird kits and one of the completed models.

A question was raised regarding indoor flying at Lancaster on week days. **Chris Vanderbilt** agreed to check on the availability of the facility during the week.

**Monte Rorie** told us that the Dallas RC Club will host an electric fun-fly at their Seagoville field. It will be on a Saturday, with the date to be established later.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 pm.
