

July 2010 Meeting Minutes

Ralph Snow reported \$3998.84 in the club treasury as of July 23rd.

The attendees reviewed the Field Rules for flying at Eastfield, which had been worked up by Ron Romeo. It was agreed that Item 3 would be revised to add small electric free flights to the list of models which are permitted to be flown. Item 4 will be revised to add "when occupied" referring to the soccer fields. Item 6 will have "powered and non-powered sailplanes" added and Item 8 will have "Pedestrians have the right of way when crossing the field" added. Ron plans to post the rules on the club website soon.

Warren Bean reported that he is waiting for Gary Warner to send him the rules for the Scale event. Warren has been in contact with Greg Judy relative to the event trophies and reported that Greg is ready to go on those.

Ralph Snow showed a spinner which he had obtained from the Tru Turn company. The company had custom-cut the spinner to accommodate a Sonic-Tronics folding prop. They will cut slots in their spinners to fit any propeller.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 AM.
