

June 2010 Meeting Minutes

This month's meeting was held June 12<sup>th</sup> at the Eastfield College flying site. There were 7 members in attendance. .

Ralph Snow reported \$3998.68 in the club treasury as of June 11<sup>th</sup>. Subsequently, this figure was found to be incorrect, due to the insurance fee for the cub scout flight demo not being accounted for. The corrected treasury balance was \$3978.68.

Ralph agreed to prepare a write-up with photos concerning the cub scout flying demonstration and send it to the AMA District VIII VP and the local Associate VP, for possible insertion in Model Aviation. It was reported that Brent Cookston, the proprietor of A-1 Hobbies, was pleased with the conduct of the event and will donate a kit for the drawing at the DEAF-24 Fly-In.

It was decided that the drawing for prizes at DEAF-24 would be open to fliers registered for the event as part of the registration fee.

Warren Bean reported that he had talked with Greg Judy concerning trophies for DEAF-24 and that Greg had suggested 20 ounce glasses suitably engraved. It was decided that Warren should give Greg the go-ahead on that idea. Warren reported that he was thinking about possibly having trophies for the smallest and largest models if the club can agree on what measurements should be used.

It was reported that Kirk Massey of New Creations would not come to DEAF-24 this year.

It was decided that the process for a club member to register on the web site should include a means of electing whether or not the member's email address and/or phone number should appear on the member roster.

Ralph reported that he had sent the DEAF-24 flyer via email to the contact persons for a number of model clubs in the D/FW area. He agreed to widen the distribution to include more District VIII clubs. He also agreed to check with the AMA club secretary to ascertain whether our Eastfield insurance coverage includes Park Pilot AMA members.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 AM.
