

This month's meeting was held April 10th at the Eastfield College flying site. There were 6 members in attendance. .

Ralph Snow reported \$4187.33 in the club treasury as of April 9th. Ralph reimbursed Warren Bean for the cost of applying for the AMA sanction for the September 2010 Fly-In. This event will be known as DEAF-24. Warren reported that he has received tentative approval for the September 25/26 dates for the event, and that those dates are agreeable to the Dallas R/C Club.

There was further discussion concerning the DEAF 24 event, leading to the following decisions:

1. Local hobby shops will be asked to donate items to be raffled. Members may also contribute items as long as they are complete kits or serviceable equipment. The raffle will be open to the fliers who register for the event and will be included in the registration fee. Shops contributing raffle items are to be acknowledged on the event flyer.
2. Ralph agreed to contact Greg Judy for his ideas for trophies for this year's event.
3. The rules for the All-Up-Last-Down event will be battery capacity limited to 1500 mah, any number of cells, any motor, and 2.4GHz radios.
4. There will be two Stand-Off-Scale classes; one for models built by the contestant from scratch or kit, and one for ARF/RTF models.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 AM.
