

February 2011 Meeting Minutes

This month's meeting was held February 12th at the Eastfield College flying field. There were 10 members in attendance.

Ralph Snow reported \$3488.74 in the club treasury as of February 11th. This was after donating \$100 to the Frontiers of Flight Museum in memory of Jack Hamilton and sending \$90 to AMA for the 2011 club charter and insurance.

Ron Romeo reviewed the information received from Jim Rice (AMA District 8 VP) concerning the ongoing negotiations between AMA and FAA relative to the proposed rules being developed by the FAA governing unmanned air vehicles (including model aircraft). We are told to look for more information in the March issue of Model Aviation. The final rules proposal is expected to be published in late summer for public comment.

Warren Bean discussed preparation for DEAF-25 in September. It was suggested that a preliminary version of the flyer be prepared for inclusion with the letters to be mailed to solicit raffle prizes. Ralph Snow stated that he will take care of mailing those letters once the list of potential donors has been finalized. Frank Korman agreed to summarize the information from the flyer and send it to the various magazine columnists who write about our segment of the sport.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 AM.
