

November 2010 Meeting Minutes

This month's meeting was held November 13th at the Eastfield College flying site. There were 7 members in attendance.

Ralph Snow reported \$3648.32 in the club treasury as of November 12th.

The fact that the weather was marginal for flying led to a discussion about where the club should meet if the flying had to be canceled. The general feeling was that we should find a place to meet indoors in bad weather so that the meeting can always be held on the second Saturday, therefore avoiding confusion. Ralph reported that he had learned that the rules had again changed for the Samuell Grand Recreation Center. They no longer charge a \$25 fee for reserving a room for the year. Instead the charge will be \$10 per hour, per meeting. Therefore the club is not out anything if we decide not to meet at S-G.

One possible meeting location was suggested by Billy Holliman. His church is located in Mesquite, not far from Eastfield College and Billy was sure that a meeting room could be made available there. An advantage for that location would be the possibility of doing some indoor flying after the meeting. Another possible venue would be in one of the Eastfield College buildings. Ron Romeo agreed to check out that possibility if Ralph could identify a contact person at the college.

Warren Bean reported that he has applied to AMA for the event sanction for DEAF-25, and that he has designated it as a three-day event. Friday flying at the field will be open to any type of power at the request of DRCC. It was suggested that an indoor flying session could be held on Friday evening, and could possibly take place at the new Seagoville Rec Center. One of the Seagoville center workers is also currently working at the Ridgewood site and suggested we should look at indoor at Seagoville. Warren will check with that person at our next session at Ridgewood. The Lancaster Rec Center should also be checked out.

The members present voted to retain the current club officers for another year.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 AM.
